	Comprehensive Review of Transportation logistics at Maine Huts & Trails
Internship Title	Trails
Position Description	<p>Maine Huts & Trails operates four huts (eco-lodges) which are located an average of 10 miles apart along a 50 mile linear trail. Our guests have the opportunity to travel from trailheads near each hut and enjoy hut-to-hut travel as well. We offer full-service (provide food) for guests in our summer and winter seasons. In order to support hut operations and gear shuttles for guests, MH&T staff regularly travel many miles via snowmobiles and other vehicles.</p> <p>MH&T is interested in conducting a comprehensive review of the logistics of this complex transportation system and the impact, financially and environmentally, of the current system. This results of this review will help the organization make strategic decisions regarding options for service delivery.</p> <p>Responsibilities of this intern would be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Learn about and becoming familiar with Maine Huts & Trails, its current model of operation and offerings. 2) Review and collect data on MH&T's current transportation model that will inform service delivery choices for the organization going forward. Data collected would include miles traveled by type of vehicle and estimates of associated costs. 3) Review transportation and delivery model options that would continue to serve needs of guests, be economically viable but also consider the organization's goal to minimize the environmental impact of our system. Organize data in format(s) that will inform and engage decision makers. 4) Present a summary of the research and findings and recommendations to MH&T staff and Colby College academic advisors.
