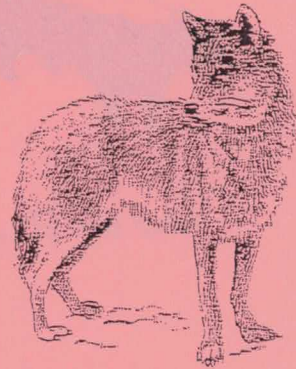
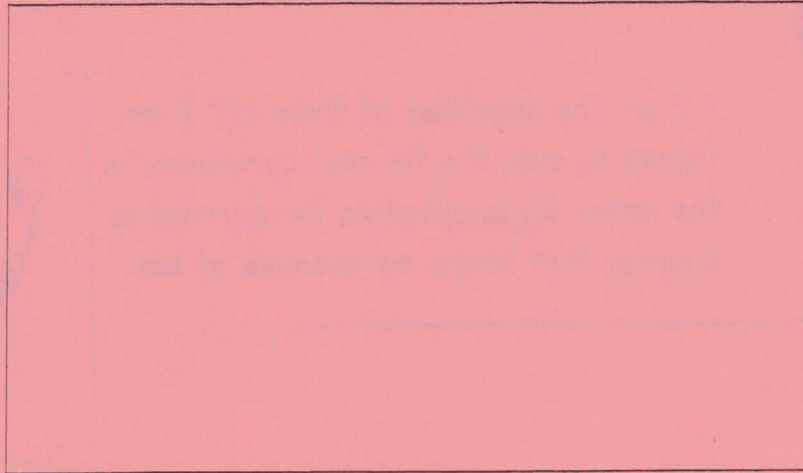
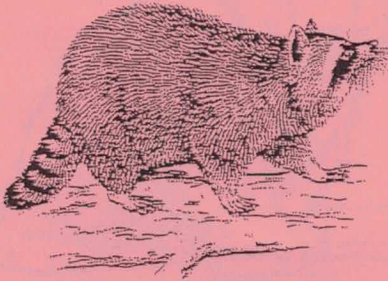


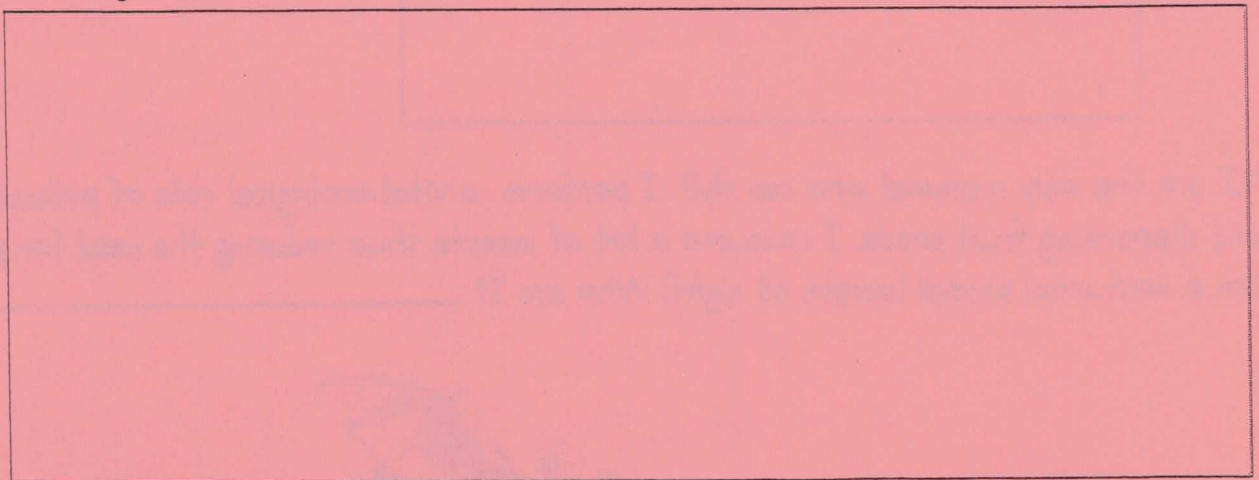
5. Try to find 3 mammals with antlers in the room. What do you think they use their antlers for? Can you draw a picture of an animal with antlers?

What kind of animals we can find today on our safari in Maine? Write them down or draw a picture when you find them in the mammal room.

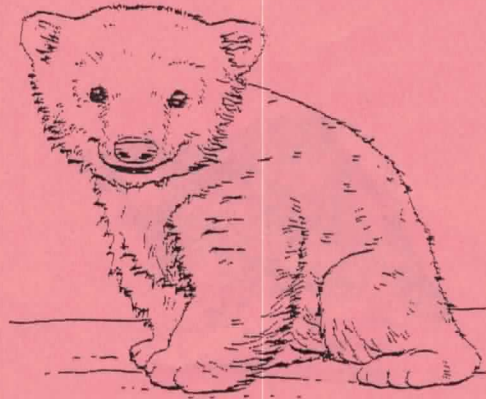


1. I am the smelliest of them all? I am feared by even the fiercest carnivores in the room. My adaptation for survival is a spray that keeps my enemies at bay.

2 I am the biggest baby in the room. I am a little black fella who learns by playing, just like humans do! I like to take long naps in the winter. (hibernation)

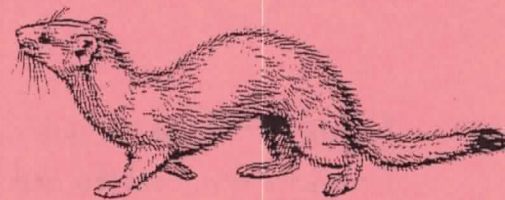
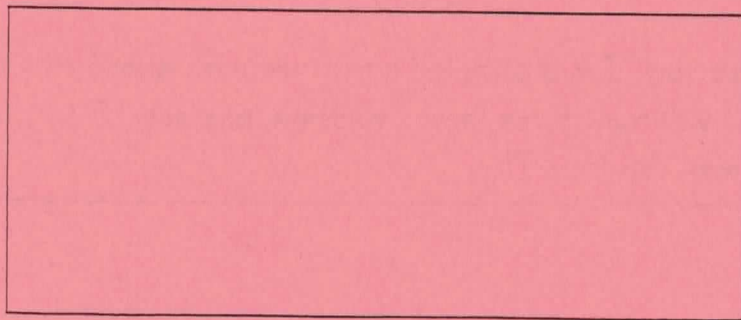
